

## (1) AUTHOR REVISION

### Authors revision criteria

- Is the global structure of the chapter well organized and well balanced? (**structure**)
- Is the chapter written with the length necessary for all relevant information (maximum 1000 words)? (**length**)
- Is the chapter logically consistent? (**logic**)
- Are the different sections of the chapter well articulated? (**flow**)
- Is English readable and good enough to convey the scientific meaning correctly? (**language**)
- Does the argumentation use the PEC system? (**argumentation**):
  - Make your POINT
  - EXPLAIN how and why the point is relevant
  - Discuss the CONSEQUENCES of the point made

### Authors revision phases

- Reviewing by a **naïve reader** in the authors' own entourage (logic, readability)
- Proofreading by a **native English-speaker @ Chantelle Wiseman** (spelling, grammar, syntax)
- Micro-editing by the **author** (punctuation, typographic errors, citations, references)

## (2) PEER REVIEW

### Peer reviewers selection

- Peer reviewers may include same-level colleagues, junior colleagues, students.
- 2 to 4 peer reviewers needed per chapter.

### Peer review criteria

- Does the paper read well and make sense to you? (**readability & style**)
- Are the main concepts of the exposed psychotherapy clearly stated and well articulated? (**content**)
- Does the paper help to expand your knowledge in the field of psychotherapy? (**significance**)
- Would the exposed psychotherapy be of interest to you in your training? (**relevance**)
- Is English good enough? (**language**)
- Can you check resources/associations available in your country? (**resources**)
- Does the paper convey trainee experience? (**personal experience**)

## EXPERT REVIEW CRITERIA

### Expert reviewers selection

- Expert reviewers may include senior colleagues at our internship place, university professors, thesis chairs or even celebrity authors.
- 1 to 3 expert reviewers needed per chapter.

### Expert review criteria

- Overall, what do you think of my paper?
- Does my paper provide value?
- Does my paper fail to address any important issues or neglect references to important concepts, studies or theories?
